



# 6 Guided Tours Sail Passau to Budapest

### 9 Days / 7 Nts Apr 27-May 5/24

Apr 27: Join your Friendship Tours Escort and travel by deluxe motoroach to Logan Airport for your o/n flight to Munich Apr 28: Arrive Munich and transfer to your ship in Passau, Germany—set on the confluence of 3 rivers one of Bavaria's oldest cities. Join a "welcome walk" and get acquainted with the area. Settle in to your Viking Longship, your home for 7 Nights. Apr 29: Today you will take a walking tour of this elegant town, called the Dreiflüssestadt ("City on Three Rivers"). Admire the New Bishop's Residence and see the impressive baroque St. Stephen's Cathedral; its ornate interior is home to Europe's largest church organ.

Apr 30: Wake up in Linz, Austria this morning and set off to explore this cultural gem by mini-train and on foot. Ride along the Danube's south bank and take in the sights; see the Brucknerhaus concert hall, Linz Castle and the Market Hall, where Mozart wrote the Linz Symphony, followed by a walking tour of the city's Old Quarter.

May 1: After scenic sailing this morning through the Wachau Valley, you will arrive in Krems, Austria. Enjoy lunch on board, then depart your ship for an exclusive visit of the splendid Benedictine Abbey of Göttweig, a working monastery for more than 900 years. You may also pay a visit to a local vineyard for a tasting before returning to your ship for dinner.

May 2: Today we tour the Austrian capital of Vienna. Ride along the Ringstrasse, which replaced the city walls in the mid-19th century. See some of the city's baroque architecture, including the world-famous Opera House, St. Stephen's Cathedral and Hofburg Palace. Balance of day is free for you to enjoy this wonderful city.

May 3: Arrive in Bratislava this morning and embark on a walking tour of Slovakia's charming capital with a long and fascinating history. It is the only national capital that borders two other countries, Austria and Hungary. Enjoy scenic cruising this afternoon as we set sail toward Budapest.

May 4: Today we see highlights of the once separate towns of Buda and Pest, starting with Pest's National Opera House and historic Heroes' Square. In Buda, walk along Castle Hill to Fisherman's Bastion and Matthias Church. Enjoy lunch on board your ship, with the rest of the day to explore on your own. Return to your ship for a traditional Hungarian farewell dinner. May 5: Transfer to airport for your flights home to Boston. Your motorcoach awaits your arrival to transfer you back to CT.
