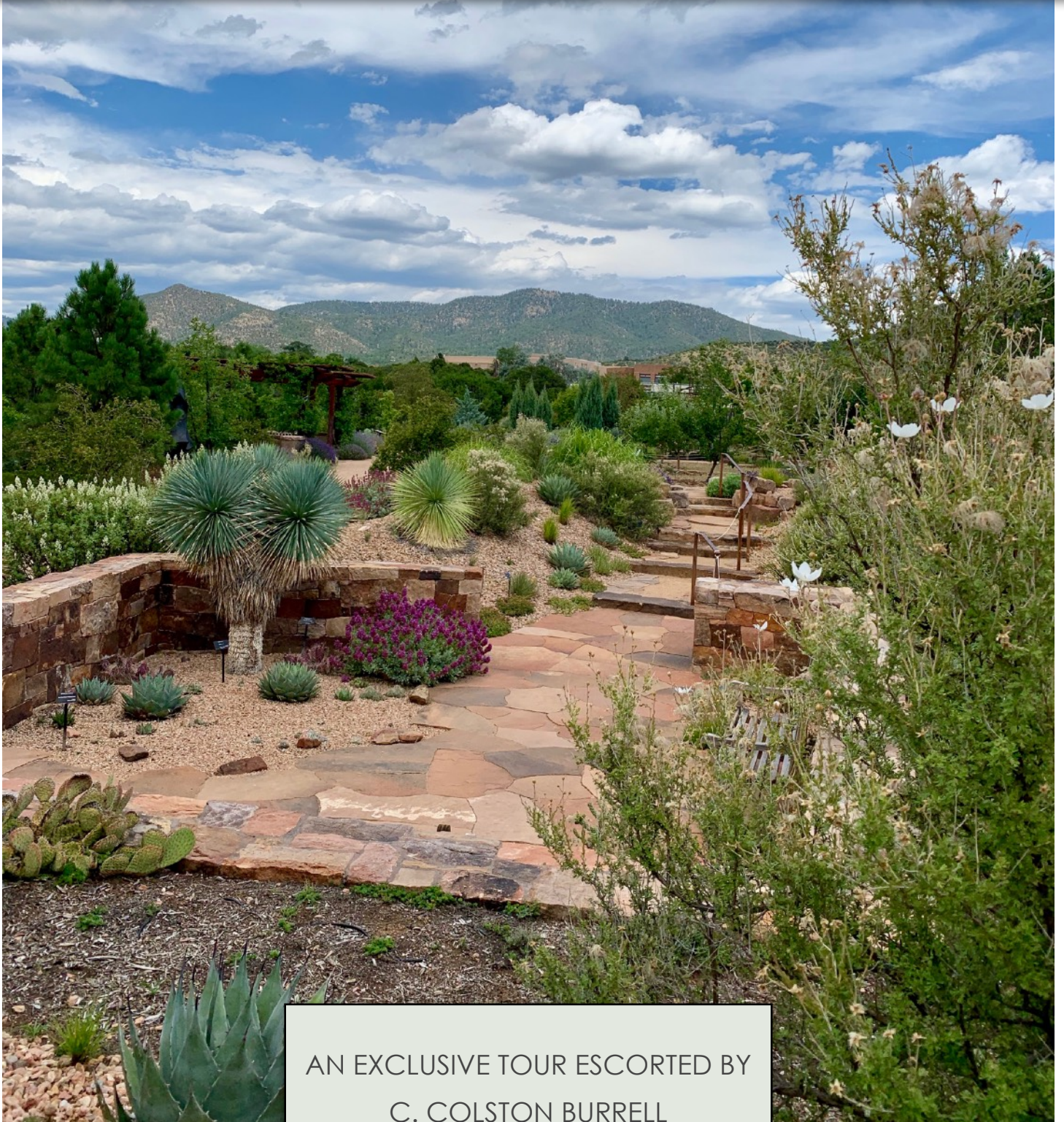
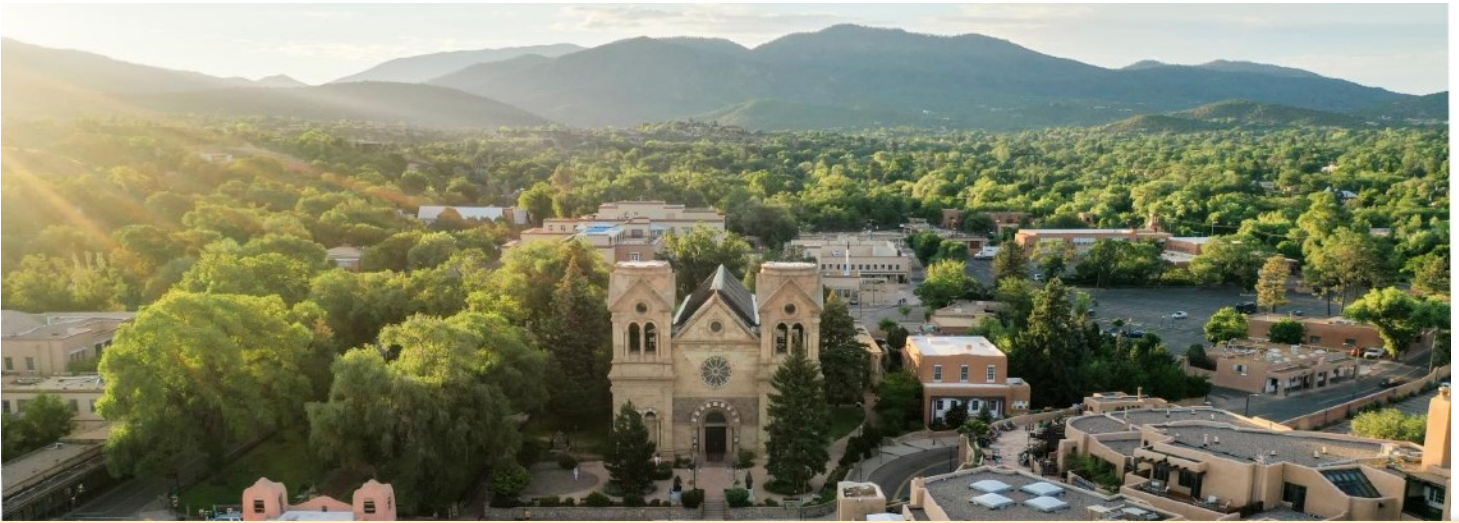


SECRET GARDENS OF SANTA FE

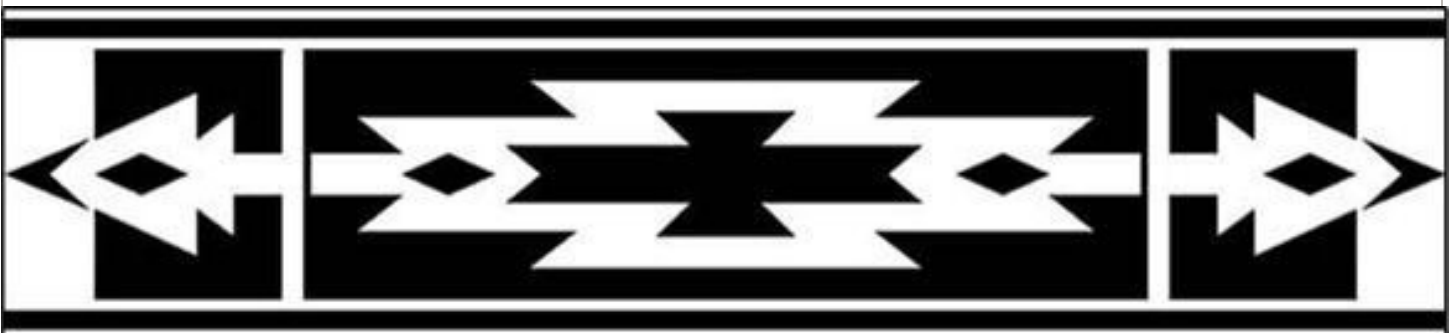
WELCOME TO SANTA FE

Join **Garden and Nature Tours with C. Colston Burrell** and **Friendship Tours** in Santa Fe, New Mexico to explore the rich cultures, storied traditions, colorful gardens and innovative cuisine of the oldest Capital city in the United States. Set against the dramatic backdrop of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, Santa Fe sits in the foothills at just over 7,100 feet elevation. Here you discover over 1000 years of culture, history and tradition.

Santa Fe is renowned for its Pueblo-style architecture and as a creative arts hotbed. Founded as a Spanish colony in 1610, it has at its heart the traditional Plaza. The surrounding historic district's crooked streets wind past adobe landmarks including the Palace of the Governors, now home to the New Mexico History Museum.

Visit a collection of private and public gardens including Santa Fe Botanic Garden and Georgia O'Keeffe's home at Abiquiu. Flowers abound in pocket gardens, painterly streetscapes and colorful window boxes throughout the city. Peruse the collections of modern and folk art at world-class galleries. Explore the historic city and delve into ancient and contemporary indigenous art and culture.

The name "Santa Fe" means 'Holy Faith' in Spanish, and the city's full name as founded remains La Villa Real de la Santa Fe de San Francisco de Asís - 'The Royal Town of the Holy Faith of Saint Francis of Assisi'.

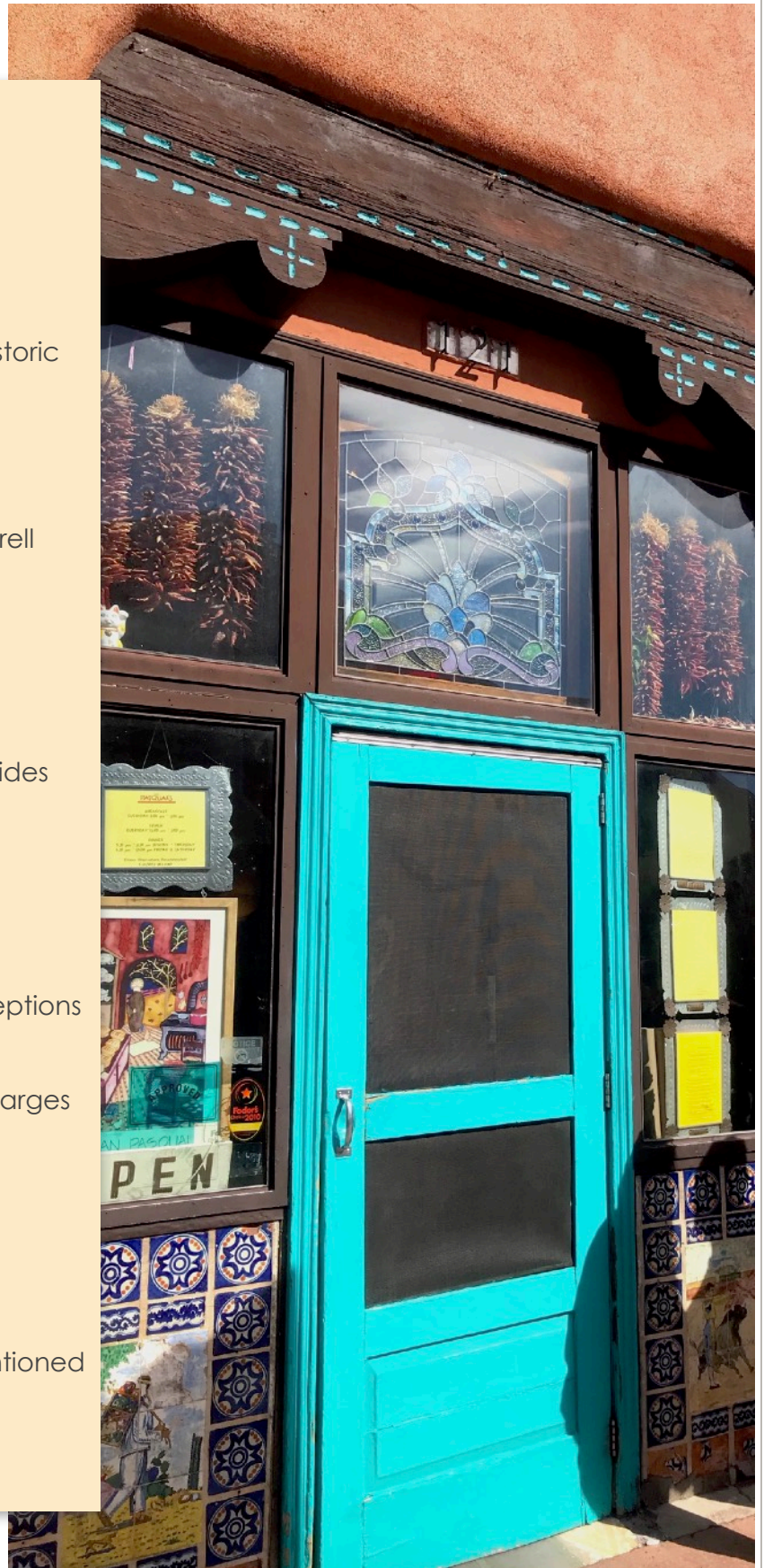
